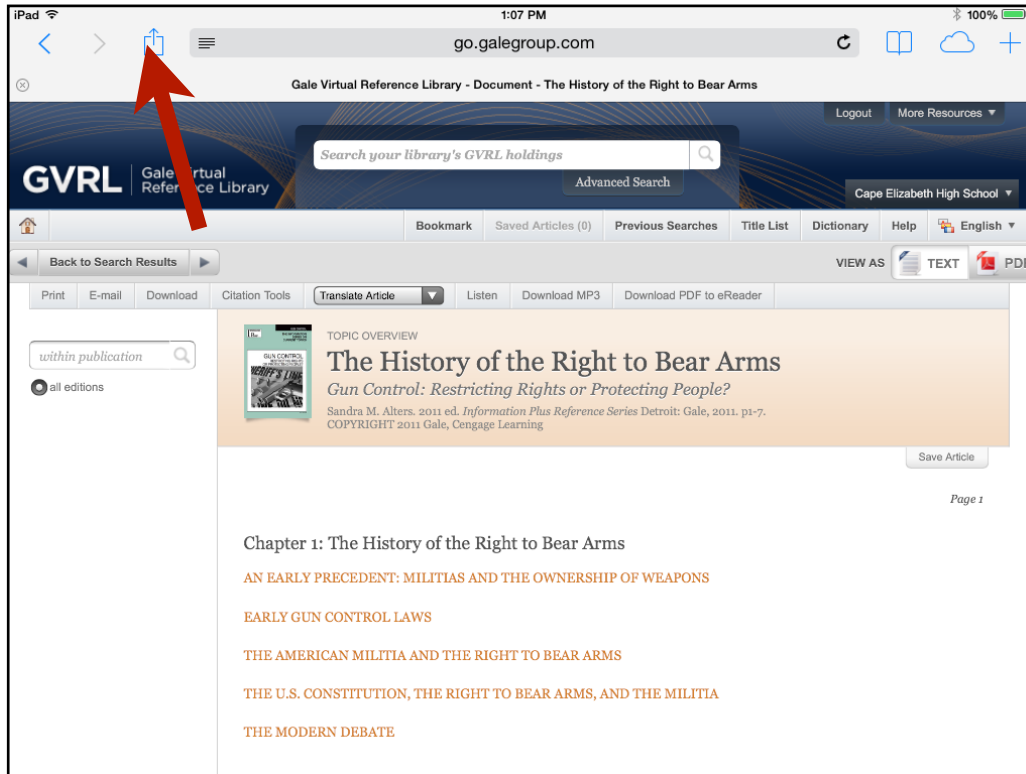
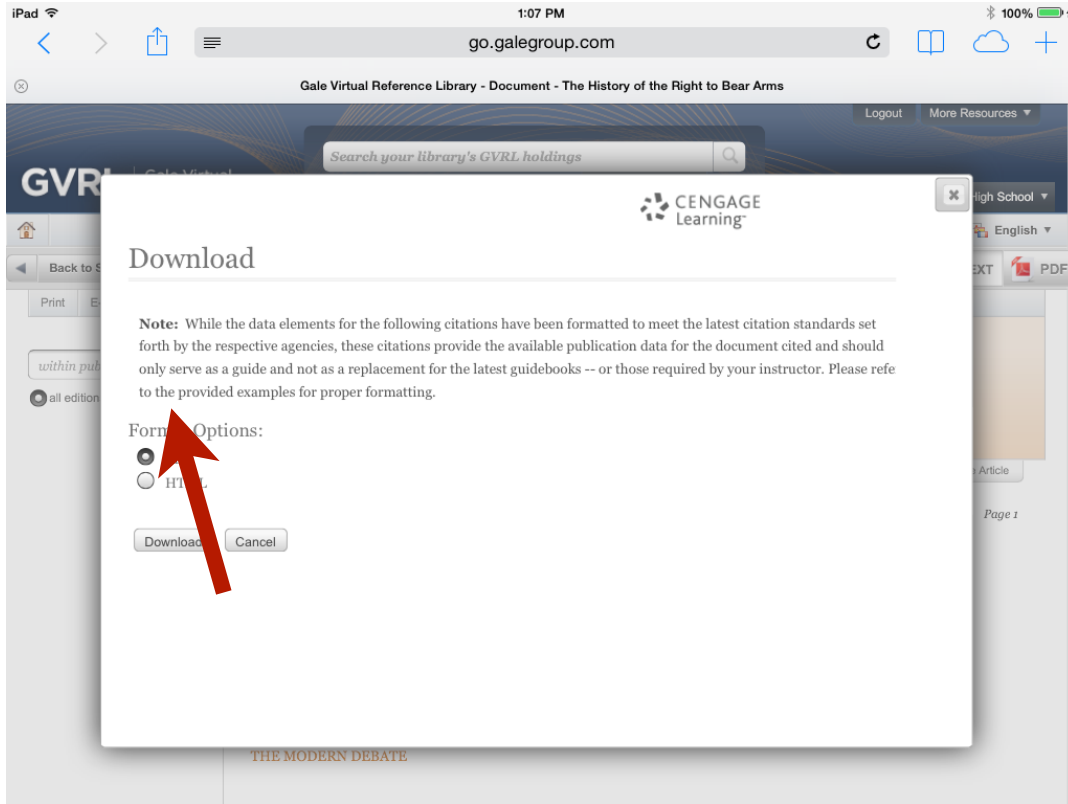


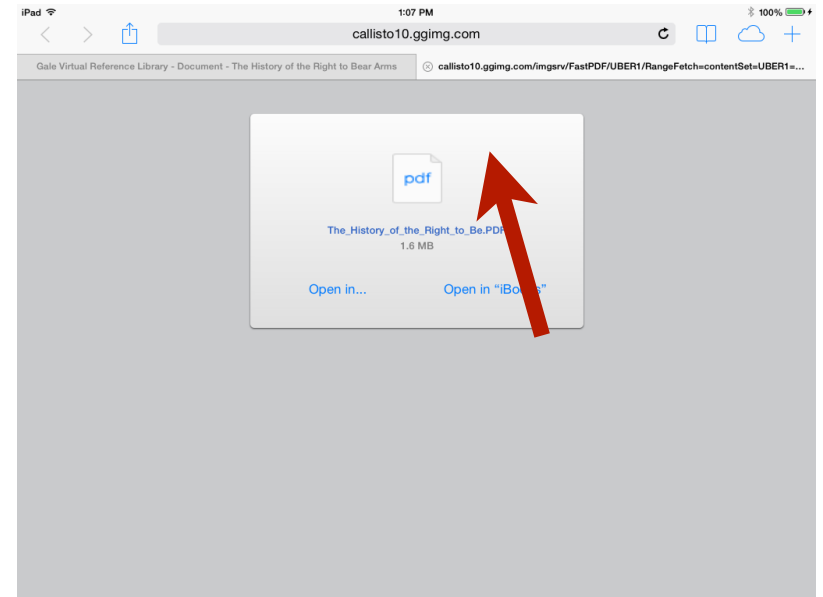
Saving a GVRL article to an iPad



Once you have found an article that you think is a good fit for you, you can save it to your iPad for annotation and to keep track of your research. Click **“Download”** on the left of the page.



Click “Download” again and the “Open in iBooks”



To learn how to collect the book’s information for your bibliography scroll down.

Return to the article's page in Safari. **Click the title** of the book that the article is from. It is in *italics* and is directly under the article title
